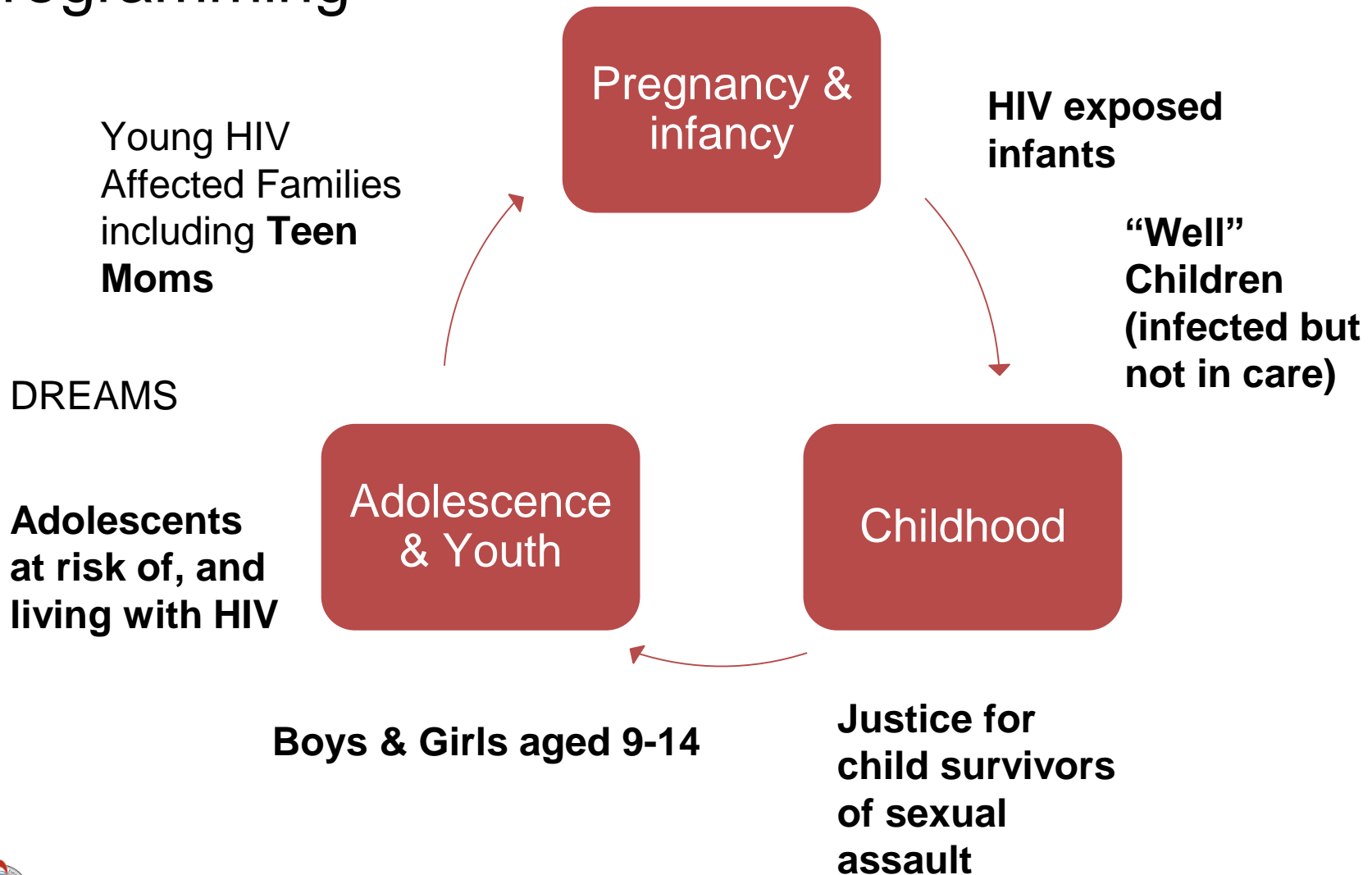

Multiple Sub-Populations: Different Range of Needs, Intensity and Program Approaches

Children in crisis**

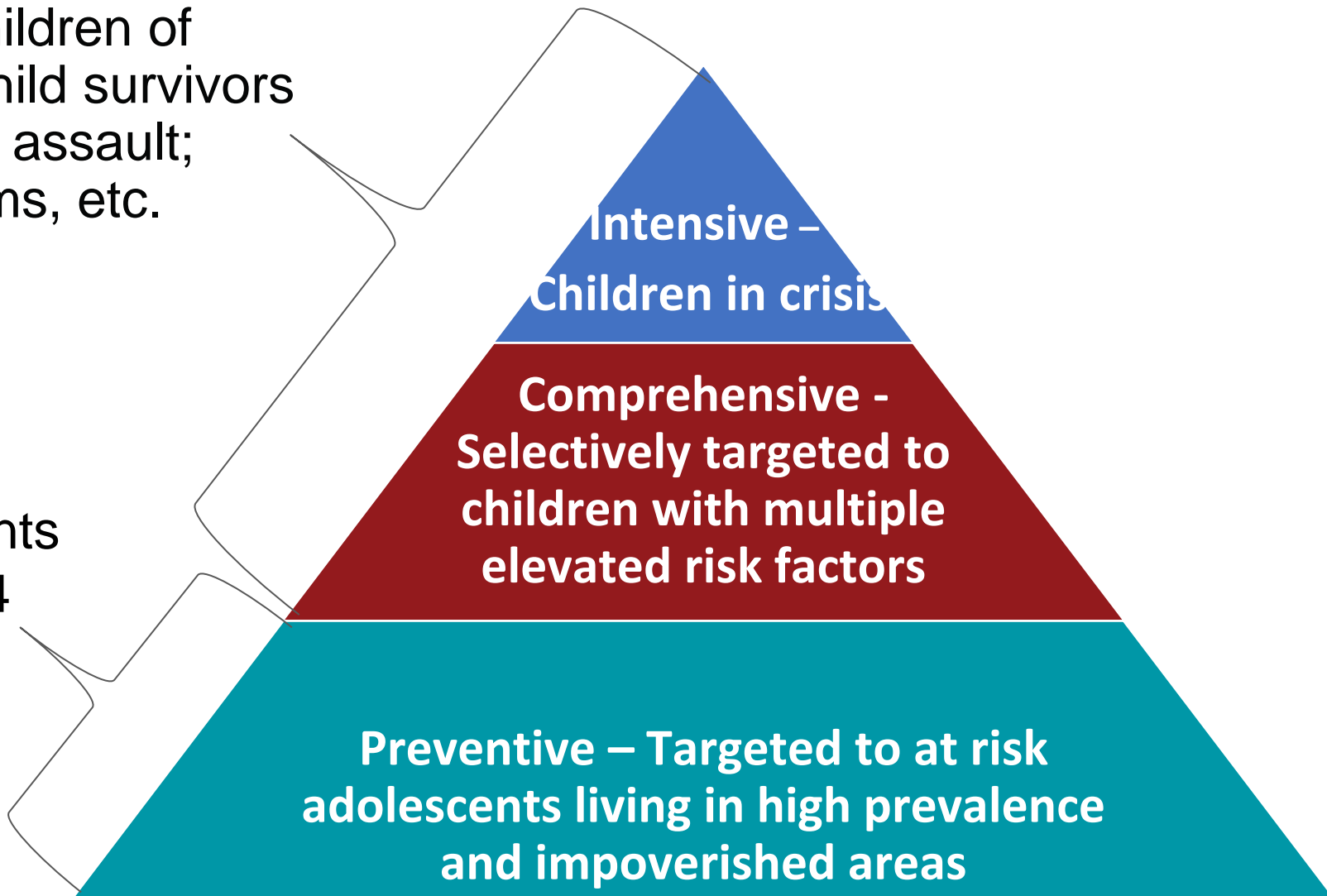
**Comprehensive -
Selectively targeted to
children with multiple
elevated risk factors**

**Preventive – Targeted to at risk
adolescents living in high prevalence and
impoverished areas**



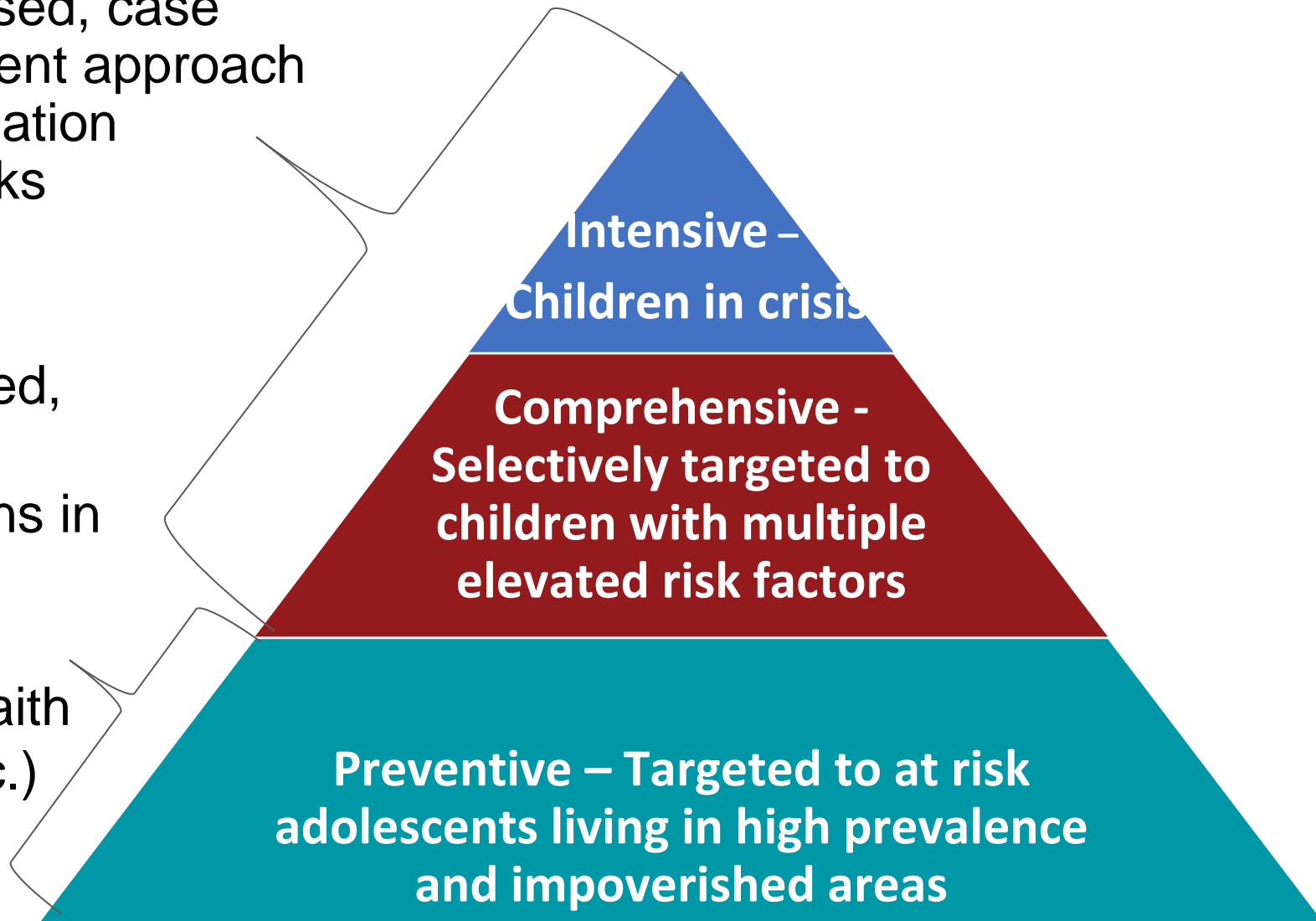
Children living with HIV, exposed and LTFU; children of FSWs, child survivors of sexual assault; teen moms, etc.

Adolescents aged 9-14



Family-based, case management approach with graduation benchmarks

Time Limited, group interventions in community settings (schools, faith groups, etc.)



Number & comprehensiveness of interventions (and cost) increases from Preventive to Intensive

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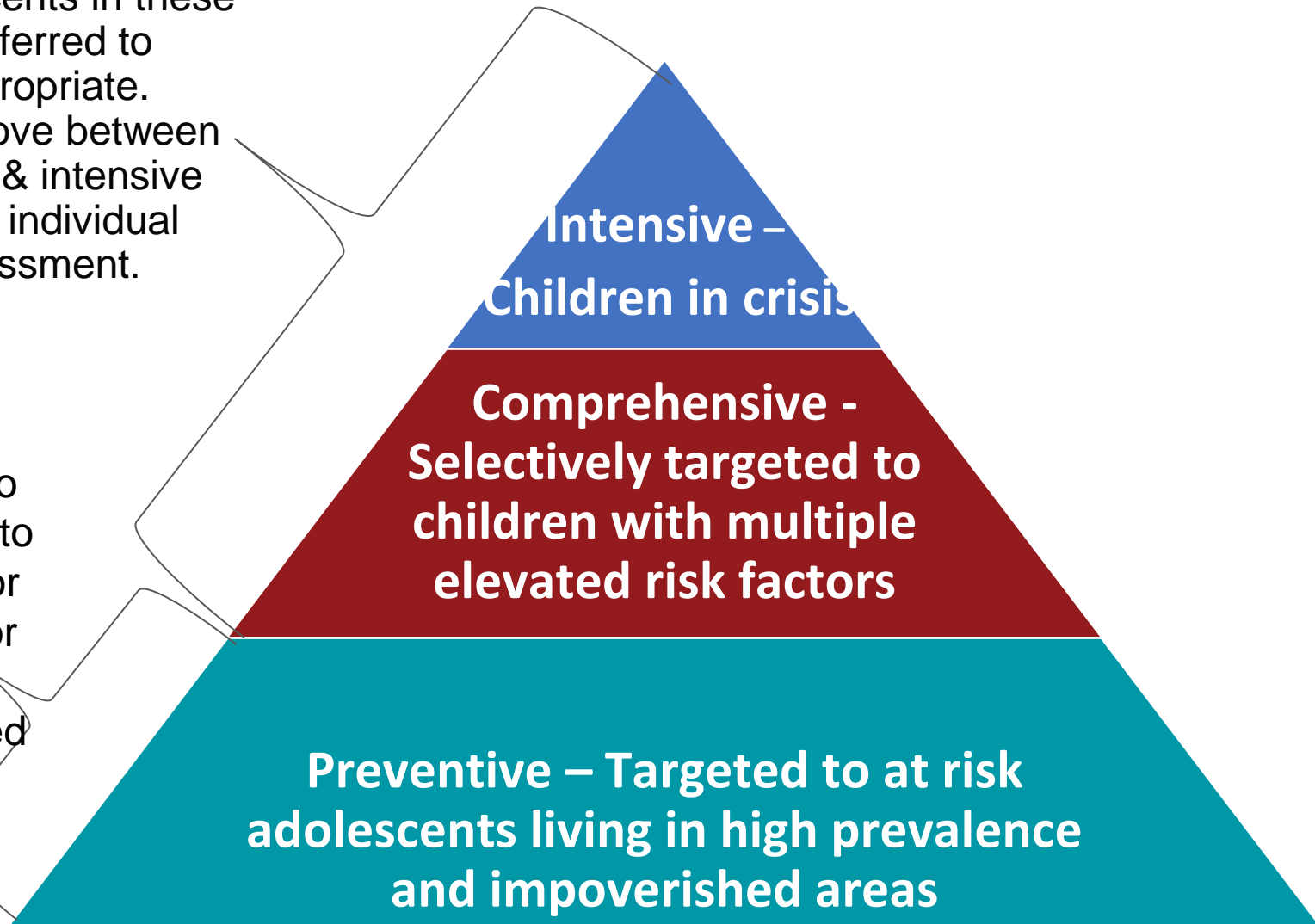
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Number of children reached progressively increases from intensive to preventive



Female adolescents in these levels can be referred to DREAMS if appropriate. Children can move between comprehensive & intensive levels based on individual and family assessment.

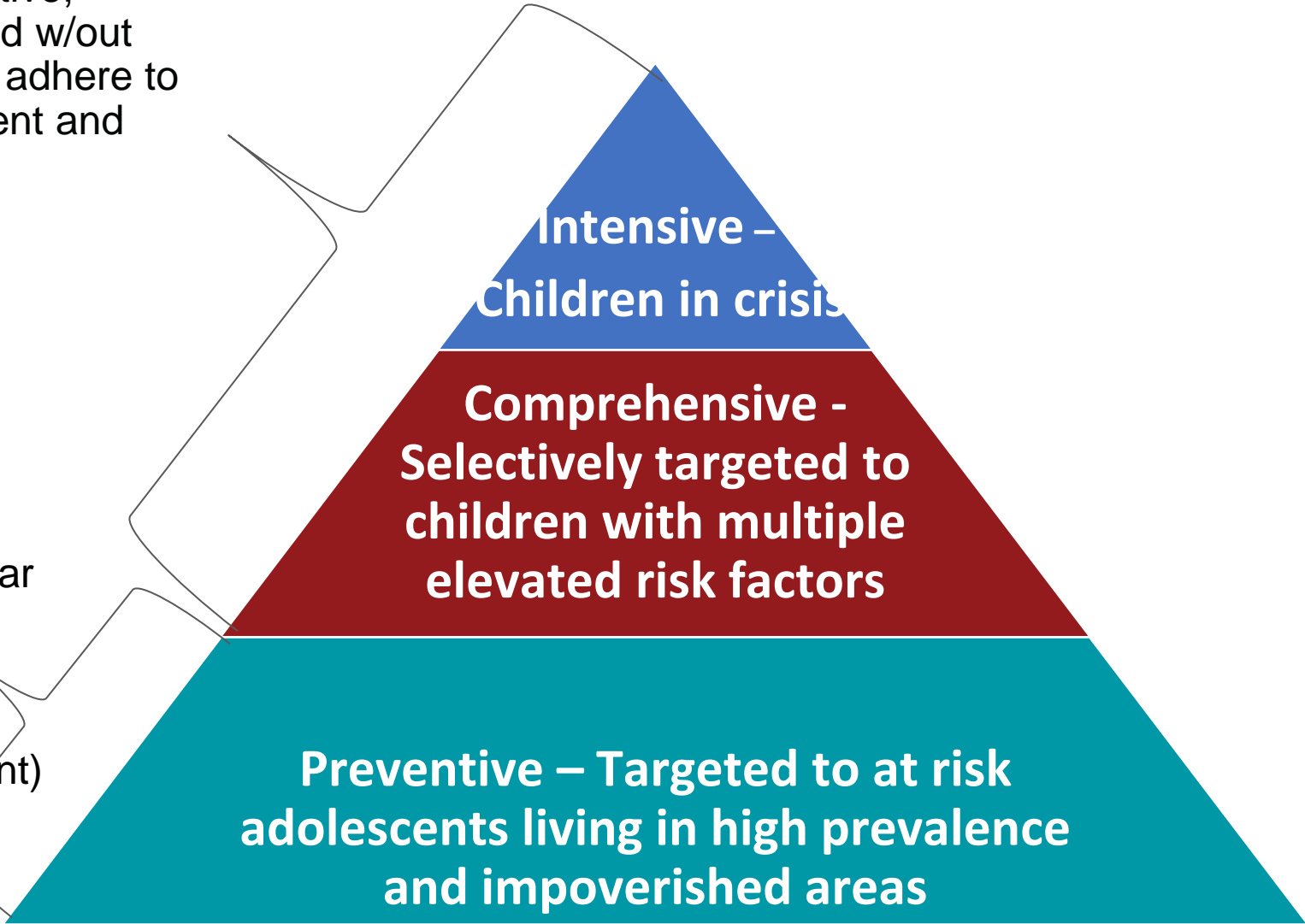
Can be referred to DREAMS and/or to Comprehensive or Intensive Level for eligibility assessment based on “risk signs”
